

We believe that one of the trees is growing in a church ground in Te Kuiti.

This olive tree root was dug from the earth in the garden of Gethsemane on Sunday morning, the 22nd of December 1957.

It is sent at the request of the Reverend W. Gardiner Scott, and with the blessing of the Abbess Maria at the Church of St. Mary Magdalen at Gethsemane.

Jerusalem 22nd December 1957.

Three olive saplings growing from roots of the most ancient olive trees in the Garden of Gethsemane, were sent as described on the accompanying note set in this frame.

They were packed and sent by air freight, by Miss Caryon of the British Consulate General in Jerusalem, and arrived in Morrinsville on the Feast of Epiphany, Monday 6th January 1958.

Two cuttings were cared for by Mr. T.H. Hooker, and one by Mr. J.S. Wigelsworth in their respective nurseries.

The tree in the courtyard of the church was planted by the Reverend David Calder after morning service on Sunday 28th September 1958.
