Hospital Chaplaincy Aotearoa formerly Interchurch Council for Hospital Chaplaincy (ICHC). After more than 30 years as ICCHC and a history of over 50 years of providing spiritual care to hospital patients and staff, ICCHC has a new name. While the name and logo is changing, "our mission remains steadfast. Our chaplains continue to walk alongside patients, families and healthcare staff, offering spiritual care that touches lives in profound ways."

In December, Knox congregation received the Heartfelt Supporter newsletter and also a letter thanking us for the support we have offered to ICCHC over the years. Following Helen's presentation it has been decided to support Nick and Georgia financially on a monthly basis for this current financial year (1 June 2024 - 31 May 2025).
